46 data sets in total are in the "Territories" folder.

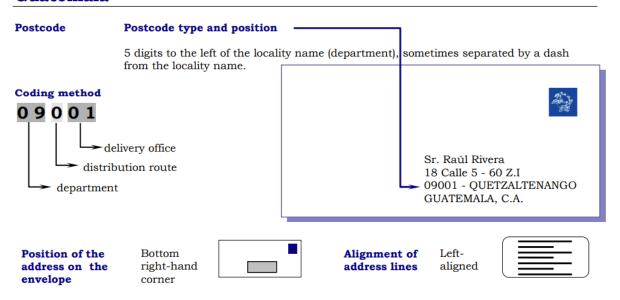
276 data sets in total are in Universal POST*CODE® DataBase.

The 2025.2 release of the Universal *POST*CODE®* DataBase includes a new dataset for Guatemala providing newly 19,400 sub-localities with their related postcodes.

Correos of Guatemala asks all mailers to always include "C.A." (standing for Central America) in the last line of the address following the country name, to support international routeing.
